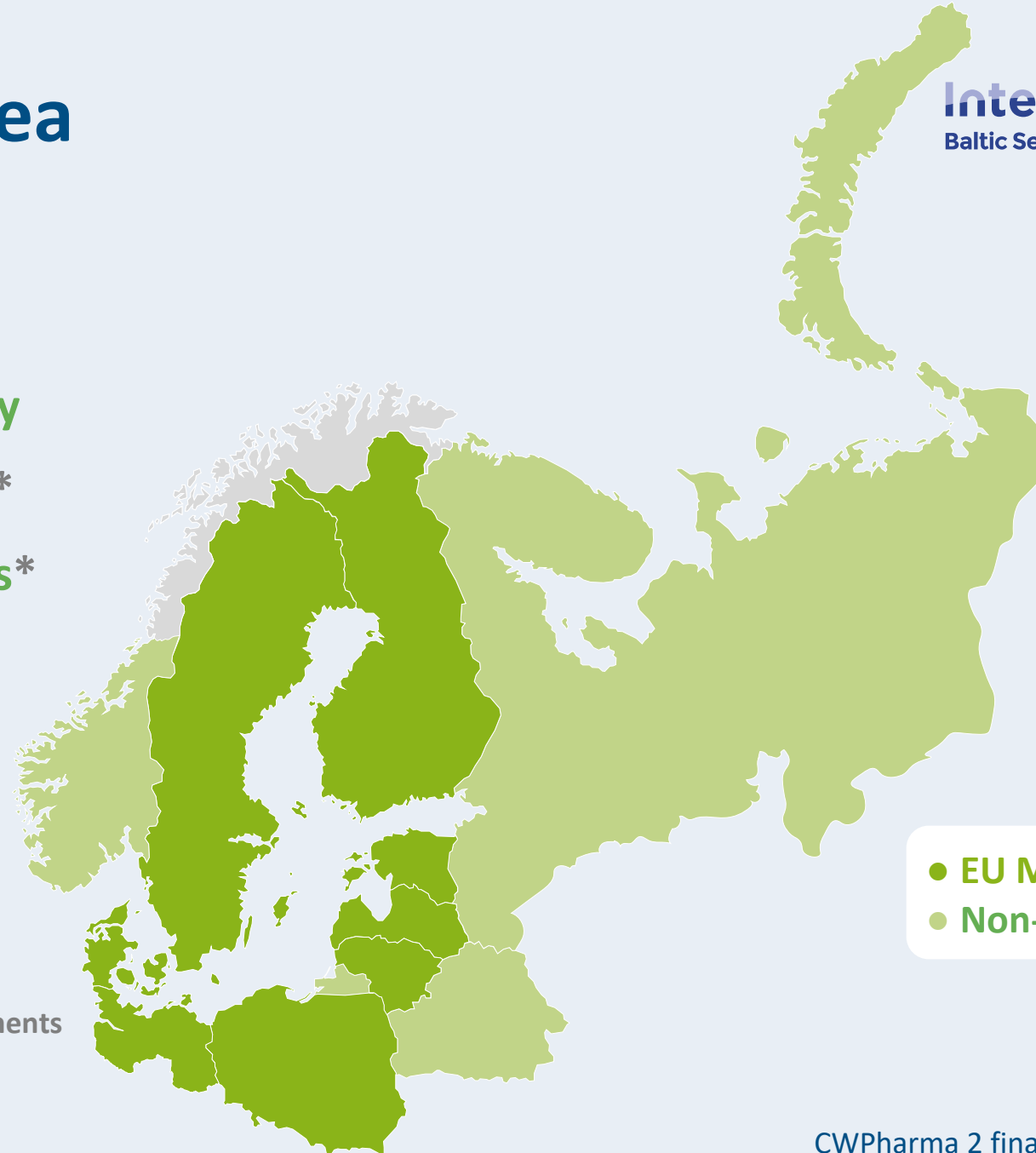

# Priorities 1 – 3

## Project types

### Core projects

- **Focus:** practical & durable solutions / piloting
- **Partners:** at least 3 organisations from 3 IBSR countries
- **Duration:** up to 36 months
- **Budget:** no limitation (proportionate to activities)

### Small projects

- **Focus:** easier access & implementation /especially for **new** partners
- **Partners:** at least 3 organisations from 3 IBSR countries
- **Duration:** up to 24 months
- **Budget:** up to EUR 500,000
